- Te Manawanui is the Integrated Primary Mental Health and Addiction Service funded through the Access and Choice initiative.
- The aim of the service is to deliver a small amount of targeted, brief intervention to a large number of people.
- Te Manawanui makes a range of supports rapidly available to a general practice's enrolled population to help people manage challenges that adversely affect their wellbeing.
- These include brief interventions, support for self-management, and social and cultural supports.
- The service is designed around Taranaki Māori communities to provide mental health and addictions support that is culturally responsive, accessible, practical, and convenient.
- The service is funded by the Ministry of Health.
