- 2 x AS/NZS 4308: 2008 verified "on-site" screening devices (preferred device is Microscreen2 from SoberCheck)
- Controls for on-site screening device: either positive or negative control & pipette/syringe for applying
- Verification certificate for the screening device (if difference from Microscreen2)
- 1 x laboratory kit (either Canterbury Health Lab (CHL) or ESR
- 1 x set of combined on-site screening and laboratory testing chain-of-custody forms (either CHL or ESR): purchased from the laboratory

## NB: Cancellation of a confirmed booking will incur a penalty fee
