# Incentive Payment Schedule

### Important notes on incentives payments

- Incentive payments have been separated out and attached to equity weighted fields within each tool
- The maximum incentive payment amount described above is the maximum claimable amount based on an assessment that has been 100% completed.
- The Gen2040 incentive payment applies to pēpī Māori

### Equity weighted fields for Best Start - Pregnancy tool

## Additional incentive payments for the completion of e-referrals

- The total incentivised payment amount will be based on the number of e-referrals generated for the māmā of pēpī Māori
- The below table details each referral and associated \$ value
- Complex assessments (where e-referrals are generated for more than one referral) can trigger a payment of up to \$37.50
- Non-complex assessments generate a lesser incentive value (max \$5)
- The values are based on the assumption that complex assessments will make up 40% of all assessments, whilst non-complex will make up 60%
