HOW WE HELP

The services listed below are free of charge for **candidates** that connect with us via Te Whatu Ora's **International Recruitment Centre** recruitment campaign.

You will be supported through the recruitment process by Hauora Taiwhenua's recruitment division, NZLocums and NZMedJobs. NZLocums and NZMedJobs will manage the day-to-day recruitment process for you which covers, but is not limited to:

- 1. Onboarding**

We will conduct a comprehensive interview to assess your eligibility to work in NZ as well as your personal and family requirements.

- 2. Job-match**

We will, to the best of our ability, match you to a suitable practice to ensure the "best fit". We will co-ordinate the interview process and provide ongoing support and guidance throughout the job offer process such as assistance with contract, salary, benefits and negotiations around working conditions.

- 3. Medical registration**

We will support and guide you and the practice through the registration process with the Medical Council of New Zealand and supervision arrangements prior to your arrival in New Zealand.

- 4. Immigration**

We will provide support and guidance to you and the practice through the different immigration work visa pathways.

- 5. On Arrival in New Zealand**

We will support you upon arrival, providing information such as opening a bank account and applying for an Inland Revenue number. You are also invited to attend our 3-day orientation course specifically designed for international GPs.

COSTS COVERED UNDER THIS CAMPAIGN

- Onboarding through initial screening interviews.
- Job matching to current vacancies.
- Medical registration and Supervision process guidance and support.
- Immigration support and guidance.
- Support on arrival in New Zealand, including a comprehensive orientation (subject to terms and conditions).

COSTS NOT COVERED UNDER THIS CAMPAIGN

For clarification, although our recruitment service is free for candidates and practices through the Te Whatu Ora GP Campaign, there are some costs that are not covered. The following list is not covered by Hauora Taiwhenua:

- MCNZ application assessment fee
- MCNZ annual practicing certificate
- Any other fees associated with applying for registration with MCNZ (such as English Language test)
- INZ candidate application fees
- INZ employer accreditation and job approval fees
- Any other fees associated with applying for visas with INZ (such as medicals, international police checks)
- Medical indemnity costs
- Relocation costs
- Accommodation & Vehicle costs

Orientation
