These two new Emergency eReferral options are to be used for acute patient presentations requiring assessment through hospital specialties replacing paper-based referrals. This will streamline your patient's journey once arriving at either hospital's emergency departments for treatment by the accepting speciality.

A discussion and hand-over of care must be made to a named hospital doctor and accepted by a specialist department before sending this referral. Relevant contact numbers are listed to support this mandatory step.
