
High Suspicion of Cancer Oncology Referrals in Waikato has been updated include a question around consent to share and contact Next of Kin.

This will be for Oncology (Radiation and Medical) eReferrals, with a wider roll out TBC.



### Oncology (Radiation and Medical) eReferral addition to Patient Details ↗

1. If patient urgency is **High Suspicion of Cancer** – a question regarding consent for Next of Kin details will appear in the Patient Details section.
2. If Yes is selected for the question – fields for Next of Kin Contact details will appear.
  - a. If referring from a PMS, contact details will auto populate.
