The HealthPathways site can be accessed via single sign whilst using BPAC patient prompt or BPAC main menu, or you can access via the internet using the generic username and password.

Refer to this PDF for both options.

Accessing HealthPathways with single sign on via BPAC patient prompt or BPAC main menu will also enable you to access eReferrals using the BPAC link in the pathways.

Option 1

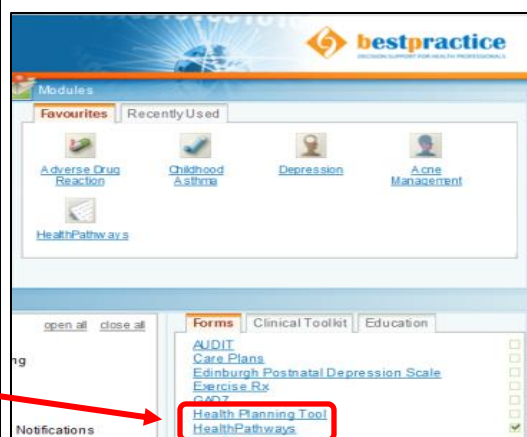
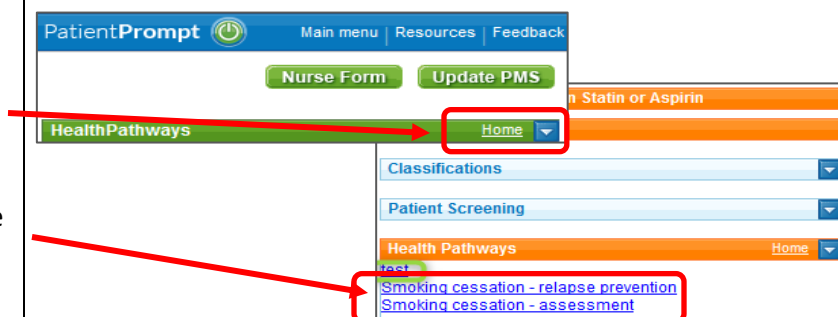
1. Open *Patient Prompt*
2. Click on 'Home' to go directly to HealthPathways; or
3. Click on the pathway link and this will take you directly to HealthPathways

The **Green banner indicates** the patient is not coded with any conditions that are directly linked to HealthPathways.

The **Orange banner indicates** the patient is coded with a condition/s that has a localised pathway to view.

Option 2

Open the *BPAC main menu* and access Healthpathways via the link.



Option 3

Choose any BPAC endpoint and related HealthPathway would be linked under Resources section, click on HP link which will take you to the relevant HP page.

If you cannot speak to the on-call doctor in one phone call, please send the patient to hospital but make a note in the ATTENTION field above.

Direct GP to ED emergency Referrals: SMO 021 759 645 *Phone call not needed unless it will change management.*
