PRESCRIPTION FOR FUNDING RATES FOR NATIONALLY CONSISTENT SERVICES FROM PHOS FROM 1 JULY 2023

- The right of the Ministry of Health to prescribe amounts payable by Te Whatu Ora to PHOs for Nationally Consistent Services is acknowledged in clause F.21 of Part F, v6.3 of the current Primary Health Organisation (PHO) Services Agreement (PHOSA).
- 2. The Ministry of Health has prescribed rates of funding that Te Whatu Ora will pay to PHOs, as set out in Part F of the current PHOSA, in respect of:
 - a. First-Level Services by Access Practices for Enrolled Persons
 - b. First-Level Services by Non-Access Practices for Enrolled Persons
 - c. Health Promotion services
 - d. Services to Improve Access for High-Need Groups
 - e. Care Plus services
 - f. Immunisation services
 - g. Rural Workforce Retention
 - h. Management services
 - i. Very Low Cost Access payments
 - j. Zero Fees for Under Sixes; and
 - k. Zero Fees for Under Fourteens
 - I. Community Services Card (CSC) holders and their dependents enrolled in practices that have opted into the CSC scheme.
- 3. An increase has been applied to (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (h), (i), (j), (k) and (l). The increased rates are specified in the tables in Appendix 1 to this letter.
- 4. All rates are to take effect from 1 July 2023.
